Sustainability	<p>Appraiser was in last week to do the appraisal on the building. Appraiser will produce 2 reports: one based on as is condition, the other based on as repaired. Expect reports by the end of July.</p> <p>Need to keep public in loop by writing regular updates to paper, similar to "Festival Notes."</p> <p>Gratitude postcards now available at desk.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Talk to Community Schools about kids doing posters modeled after the postcards to encourage people to fill them out. Would run as a poster contest <p>Revisit forming Hames Taskforce non-profit & creation of a mission statement—Paul spoke with Connie Sipe to see if we would be a fit. CFC has too much on their plate at current. Discussion around why we would form:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ To be a recognized entity from the city's view➤ Fundraising➤ Grant writing (are non-profits viewed more favorably?) <p>Are there alternatives to forming as a non-profit that would still give us status in the eyes of the assembly? Possibilities discussed: form under APOC; add to Parks and Rec commission.</p> <p>Ballot Propositions due end of August (per Colleen Pellet)</p> <p>John & Curt gave update to assembly—went "reasonably well." Followed-up with a written report. Next update on July 8.</p> <p>Get buy-in from larger community. Show that Hames is more than just a gym; that it adds to the quality of life, desirability of town, etc. Give presentation to Chamber, Rotary and SEDA regarding Hames and how it ties into their missions and advances their goals.</p>	<p>John will take the lead on this.</p> <p>John will talk with Curt about contest.</p> <p>John will talk with the City attorney and Dave Wolff regarding this.</p> <p>John and Curt</p> <p>John will schedule us with these groups.</p>
